BDT (Beretta Defense Technologies) is an alliance of **Beretta Holding Group*** companies that supply leading armed forces and law enforcement agencies worldwide with firearms, ammunition, optics, electro-optics, clothing and accessories. This uniquely wide portfolio of products and services allows **BDT** to be a single point of reference for many of the individual soldier requirements. With over € 550 million of revenue **generated in 2024**, of which over € 390 million in Europe, **BDT** is a European defence Industry leader in its segments and includes national champions like **Beretta** (Italy) together with **Sako** (Finland), **RWS** (Germany), **Norma** (Sweden) and **SwissP** (Switzerland).

The conflict between Russia and Ukraine has disproven common expectations that future warfare would be fought by predominantly unmanned vehicles, with warring parties engaging at long distances through highly technological means. In the contrary, we are facing a war reminiscent of WW1 with heavy usage of indiscriminate artillery fire and soldiers digging and covering in trenches, while making use of high intensity drone warfare. More than ever, the dismounted soldier (operating on the battlefield outside of any kind of vehicle) is a critical factor of operational success.

Since its inception in 2012, **BDT** has focused on enhancing the **dismounted soldier's capabilities of survivability, mobility, lethality, sustainability and situational awareness**. Hence, at **BDT** we are committed to supporting relevant projects within the EU programmes.

For example, we are building up European capabilities in the context of **EDF ACHILE** (Augmented Capability for High End Soldiers), where Beretta is focused on soldier mobility through advanced clothing technologies; **EDA SAAT** (Small Arms Ammunition Technology) where Beretta and SwissP are part of a European team developing the future assault rifle calibre and technology; and, **EDF E-ARMS**, which is a proposal initiated by Beretta in the frame of the EDF Work Programme 2025 to disrupt the traditional firearms technology.

Beretta (Fabbrica d'Armi Pietro Beretta SpA) is the "original Beretta company" and the oldest firearms manufacturer in the world. With roots in Northern Italy going back to 1526, the company remains under the leadership of the Beretta family, making it one of the world's oldest family-owned and family-run businesses. Combining traditional craftsmanship and investments in the latest technologies, Beretta is a leader in the markets of sports shooting, hunting, and military and law enforcement firearms.

* The **Beretta Holding Group** is an international success story, built over the last 30 years by the Beretta family through strategic acquisitions in Europe, the United States and beyond. In 2024, **Beretta Holding** represented € 1.67 billion of revenue, generated by 5,800 employees working in over 50 companies, including 20 manufacturing sites and 20 renowned brands in the sectors of firearms, optics, ammunition, silencers as well as clothing & accessories. **Beretta Holding** is, above all, a European reality, with many of the companies and workforce (over 4,700 people) working within 13 countries of the European Union, and more than half of the revenue generated in Europe.
